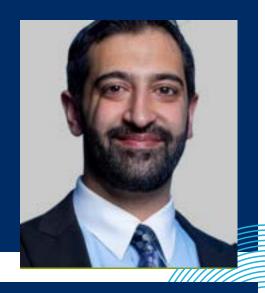

Week 1 Compass

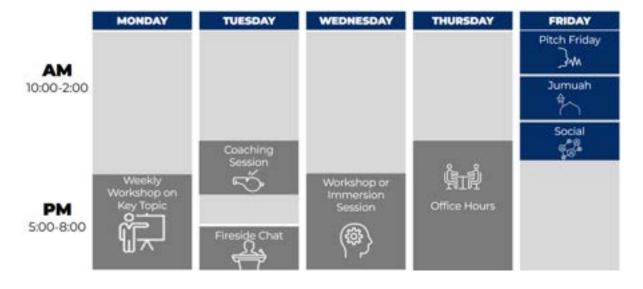

What stage in the startup process would your ideal candidate be at?

We're all about turning early-stage ideas into legit companies. If you've got a product and are ready to start making sales, you're in the sweet spot. If you're still doodling on napkins... maybe finish that first.

Is there a prize for the top pitch?

Yep. The startup squad that slays the pitch takes home \$10,000. No pressure.

Is the program available to nonprofits?

Absolutely. We're chasing impact, not profit margins. If your nonprofit idea is transformative and hits one of our focus areas, we want you.

What industries are you focused on?

Tech, Food/Beverage, Real Estate, Apparel, Construction... basically, if it's solving problems and moving the needle for the community, we're interested.

What is the time commitment required?

Expect to block evenings Monday–Thursday (5–8pm) and a half-day on Friday (10–2pm). Show up ready to grind—this is where ideas get real.

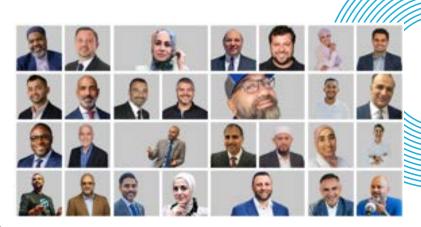
